


Image of refurbished Strength and Conditioning Suite, located in the Pavillion

### Key Responsibilities

Manage and Lead the S&C and Health Related Fitness provision throughout the school during term-time and holiday periods, including the running and management of the S&C facilities.

Implement a Long-Term Athletic
Development (LTAD) framework aimed
at improving the physical competence
and athletic performance of the
school's identified talented athletes
and sports teams in conjunction with
Coaches and Academic staff.

Provide appropriate programming support to individuals and teams that support the LTAD framework and individual need.

Design and implement appropriate physical testing, monitoring and profiling, maintaining an efficient and effective database of relevant data, considering age and stage development.

Utilise GPS and other technologies to monitor workload and support technical coaches and decision making. Collaborate with Physiotherapists to return athletes to performance, whilst actively mitigating injury risk at an individual and group level.

Support the design and running of Scholarship Days and Open Days to promote to pupils, potential pupils and parents.

Attend school sport fixtures (these may include evening and weekends).

Ensure the safety and well-being of children and young people at the school by adhering to and complying with the School's Safeguarding and Child Protection Policy at all times.

Model high standards of dress, attendance and punctuality when on the school premises and in authorised school activities off site.

Attend all training and staff INSET sessions organised by the School.

Carry out any other duties as requested by the Headmaster or members of the School Leadership Team or Director of Sport.
